The vessel is 167 meters between perpendiculars, but a full 191 meters overall. The vessel is an older ship originally built in 1973, but has received very significant upgrading to maintain her as one of the world's top category ships and to provide a superior ultra deluxe product. Her configuration and capacity are flexible and we do not believe any interior alterations will be necessary.

This is a unique very upscale ship of significant reputation and we believe her to be an excellent candidate for either a operating cruise ship, or floating hotel. The ship is in good condition and has a realistic remaining life of 7 to 10years if seagoing, or many decades if in stationary use.

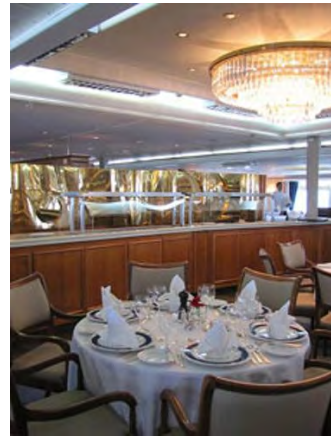

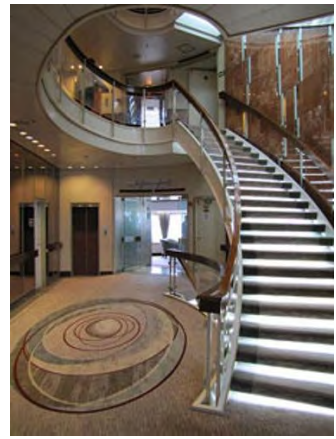

HISTORY OF OASIA

On May 22, 1973, an elegant cruise liner set off on her first transatlantic crossing from Oslo to New York. From there, the *Vistafjord*, as she was then known, began journeying through the Caribbean seas and between New York and the Bahamas. The ship, considered to be one of the most luxurious cruise ships in the world, retains her charm and sophistication to this day. Many oceans were crossed in her journeying years, before her final cruise at the end of 2013.

Timeline:

- 1973 – 1999 Ship name: *Vistafjord*
- 1999 – 2004 Ship name: *Coronia*
- 2004 – 2014 Ship name: *Saga Ruby*
- 2014 Ship name: *OASIA*
- Maiden voyage: 22 May, 1973
- *Saga Ruby* was the last Norwegian America Line Passenger ship
- Final ship in a quartet of liners built after WWII
- One of the few remaining 'classic' cruise liners. A sister ship to the QE2. A mini 'grand dame'.

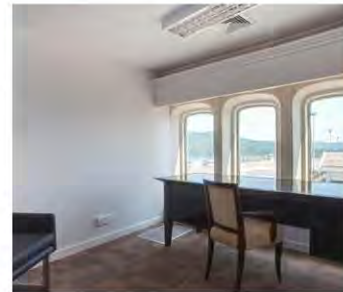
